Horner currently carries FSC-certified products from Kolbe & Kolbe, Masonite, Marshfield Doors, Mohawk Doors, Windsor Mill, Crystal Cabinets and a number of lumber suppliers.

“These FSC-certified products may help to contribute to LEED and other green building programs,” says Susan Gurry, Horner’s vice president of Marketing. “A number of employees were involved in going through the Chain of Custody certification process and enjoyed learning about it. They are excited about the certification and opportunities it presents in this tough building market. The certification is another step in Horner’s commitment to environmental practices.”

LEED, developed by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC), is an internationally recognized green building certification system, providing third-party verification that a building or community was designed and built using strategies aimed at improving performance across all the metrics that matter most: energy savings, water efficiency, CO2 emissions reduction, improved indoor environmental quality, and stewardship of resources and sensitivity to their impacts.

SCS is an independent third-party certifier of environmental, sustainability, food quality and food purity claims. Over two decades, SCS has developed internationally recognized standards and certification programs aimed at spurring the highest level of environmental improvements, social accountability and product performance. Its programs span a wide cross-section of the economy, recognizing accomplishments in the fields of green building, product manufacturing, forestry, retail, agricultural production, fisheries, energy, and food processing and handling.
